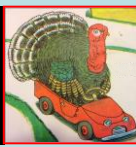
Board of Directors:

Sue and I weren't able to make the trip to Ogunquitfest this year, but from the pictures that were posted on our Facebook page it looks like they had a blast!!

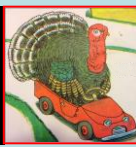
